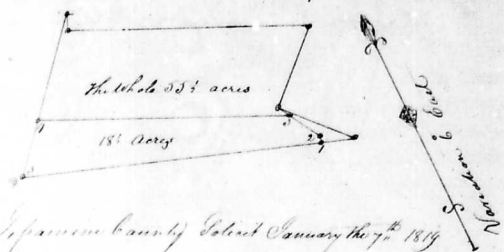

 Messrs James and Benjamin Schmitt being appointed by the said
 Court at their November Term 1818 to lay off the share right
 of Jerry Gatewood the son of Dudley Gatewood deceased in a certain
 tract of land containing 55 1/2 acres adjoining the Shawnee run
 and have directed the surveyors to lay off the same by beginning near
 the most Southwardly corner of said tract at the (point) as marked
 on the plat a stone thence N. 13 1/2 E 63 poles to the N. W. corner of a well
 at N. 29 thence N. 31 W. 21 poles to the middle of a spring in a fork
