In obedience to an order of the Jefferson County Court to us directed at their January Term 1822. being first duly sworn - we caused a survey of the Land of the late William Price decd to be made by R. Shilwell deputy Surveyor of John Henry Co. Surveyor of Jefferson County and have proceeded to lay off the same of equal value agreeable to the instructions contained in said order containing 90 Acres including the mansion house and orchard, as well as more fully appear by the plat of said survey herewith annexed and marked A. which is made a part of this report - at the same time at the request of the Heirs and Representatives of said Decd and by their joint obligation herewith annexed and made a part of this report and marked B. they being all present or represented by persons properly authorized except the Heirs of James C Price Decd. have attested to said plat the following signers viz James C Price and Lewis Price which two signers we have valued to \$1350 dollars amounting to \$575 each more than the one third part of the value of the whole of the signers belonging to the estate which balance the heirs have agreed to discharge to D. Henry during his natural life with the exception of the two 100 Acres which if they do not agree to discharge to the D. Henry agrees to pay them their proportion in the D. estate of \$575 each in the current Bank notes of the County it being the Standard of valuation The remaining four signers viz Sarah, Benjamin, Caroline and Lewis amounting in value to \$1350 is divided by the admission of the Heirs. 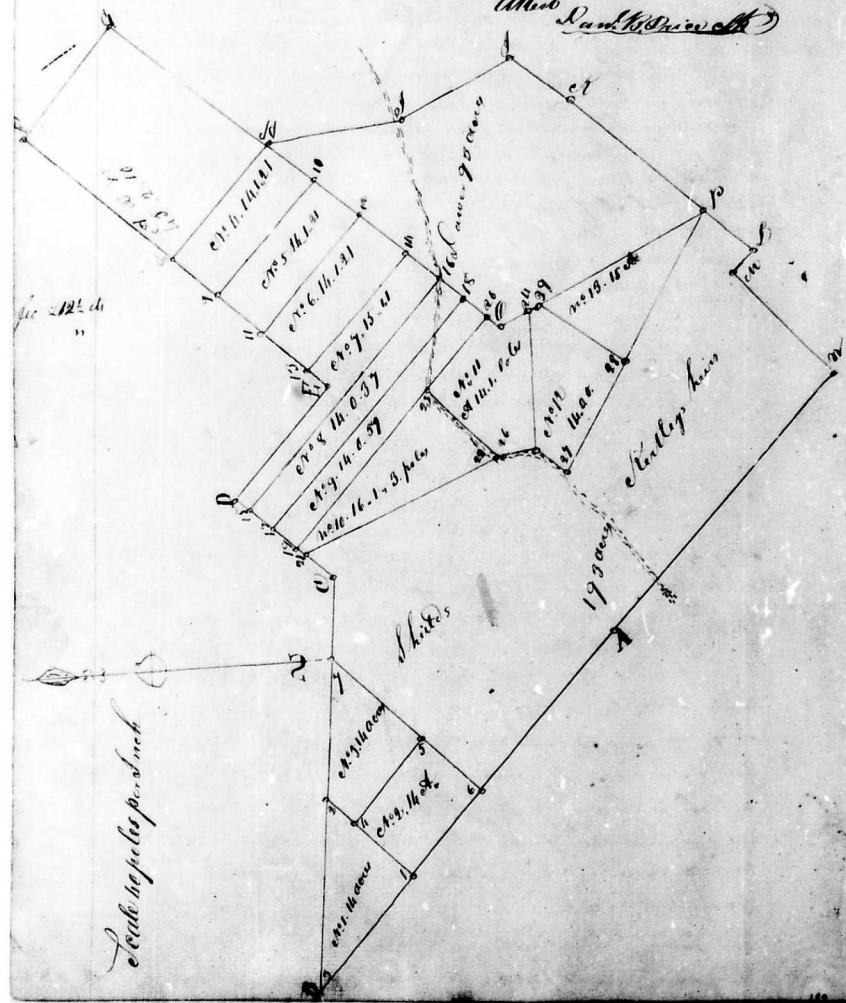

Agreeable to an order of the Superior County Court at their Term appointing Abraham Logan, John Cunningham, Joel Turnham Commissioners to attend to the record of William Davis deceased her dower &c. in the real and personal estate of her said husband and to divide the estate between the heirs of &c. and I as Deputy Surveyor for the County appeared and on the 1st day of February 1822, attended on the hands of &c. dead and by the direction of &c.
