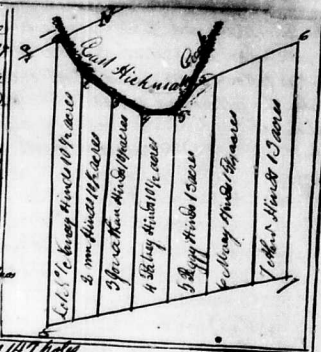

Pursuant to an order of the Jefferson County Court at their first term 1837 we the undersigned Commissioners there in appointed being duly sworn proceeded (together with Messrs. Summers as surveyor) to divide the land shown as the estate of the Hinds dec'd by the heirs of said decedent. The whole is represented by the figures from 1 to 8 in the above plate and contains 33 1/2 acres which we divided into lots as follows:



Lot N^o 1 bounded as follows, Beginning at the figure 8 a stake corner to the Meadows lower and running N 57° W 147 poles to a square on the bank of east Hickman creek, thence up creek E 2 1/2° poles thence leaving the creek S 57° E 136 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 13 1/2 poles to the beginning containing 15 1/2 acres, and allotted to Nancy Hogarth, formerly Nancy Hinds her equal share of said land. Lot N^o 2 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to Nancy Hogarth and running N 57° W 126 poles to the creek, thence up the same East 5 1/2 poles thence S 66° E 10 1/2 poles, thence S 56° E 14 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 12 1/2 poles to the beginning, containing 10 1/2 acres and allotted to William Hinds his equal share of said land. Lot N^o 3 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to William Hinds and running N 56° W 11 poles to the creek, thence up the same N 66° E 17 1/2 poles, thence S 57° E 9 1/2 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 10 1/2 poles to the beginning, containing 10 1/2 acres and allotted to Jonathan Hinds his equal share of said land. Lot N^o 4 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to Jonathan Hinds and running N 57° W 99 poles to the creek, thence up the same N 66° E 2 1/2 poles, thence N 30° E 14 1/2 poles, thence S 57° E 14 1/2 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 17 1/2 poles to the beginning, containing 10 1/2 acres and allotted to Nancy Anderson formerly Nancy Hinds her equal share of said land. Lot N^o 5 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to Nancy Anderson and running N 57° E 52 1/2 poles to the creek, thence up the same N 21° W 13 poles to a white oak on the bank of said creek, thence leaving the creek N 10° E 10 poles to a stake, thence S 57° E 14 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 20 1/2 poles to the beginning, containing 13 acres and allotted to Peggy Walker, formerly Peggy Hinds, her equal share of said land. Lot N^o 6 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to Peggy Walker and running N 57° W 11 1/2 poles to a stake, thence S 22° W 20 1/2 poles to the beginning, containing 13 1/2 acres and allotted to Mary Hinds, her equal share of said land. Lot N^o 7 bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake corner to Mary Hinds and running N 53 1/2° W 116 poles to a stake, thence N 10° E 31 poles to a white oak corner to James Houston, thence with his line S 34 1/2° E 113 1/2 poles to a white oak stump and thence corner to John Young in D. line thence with Young's line S 22° W 16 poles to the beginning, containing 13 acres and allotted to Alexander R. Hinds his equal share of said 13 1/2 acres of land.

Our Commissioners further report that the negro property belonging to the said estate exclusive of the Meadows lower could not be divided in kind as it appeared to us that there was but one Negro subject to distribution among seven distributees all of which is respectfully submitted. Given under our hand August 15th 1837.
