I Martin Whip being of sound and disposing memory and conscious from my advanced age and weakness of my body that my avocation is near at hand after commencing my soul to God I make this my last will and Testament touching my temporal estate. Item, First, To my dearly beloved wife Hannah Whip I will and bequeath the farm upon which I now live together with all other lands which I own in the County of Jepamine, and all other singular my goods chattles and personal estate of every description whatever during his natural life. It is however my will and desire that my son John Whip shall live upon the farm, and have the sole management and control of all the estate, real and personal hereto devised to my wife, and after appropriating so much of the proceeds and profits of the same as may be necessary for her maintenance and support to her use during life that he shall be in no way accountable after her death to any person for any surplus which may remain in his hands. Item, Second, It is also my will and desire that after the decease of the my wife Hannah, that my son John Whip shall have all the lands, goods and chattles and personal estate devised to her by this will, in full ample in paying to my son Adam Whip one hundred Dollars during his term of this state. Item, Third, It is my will and desire that my grand daughter Mary Whip daughter of my son John Whip shall have my young man my four year old which share is occupied out of the bequest to my wife Hannah, hereby revoking and canceling all or any will heretofore made by me inconsistent with this. I therefore affix my my hand and seal this the twenty second day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty seven
