Allen the 23rd day of Sept 1832 and stated the above acct of the balance of the Executors & after comparing it with the vouchers there & then presented which we deemed legal vouchers all of which we have numbered from 37 to 58, there are a few other charges for insolencies &c &c commission &c commissioners fees for this settlement which we deem just & reasonable & a small balance left in the Executors hands to meet supposed fees &c which is to be accounted for hereafter, and after striking the balance find that the sum of \$3878 is still in the hands of the Executors and due the Estate at this day all which is hereby reported to court given under our hands the 23rd day of September 1832.
