Agreeable to an order of the Jefferson County court at their Sept. term 1832 appointing the undersigned commissioners to appraise the personal estate and slaves of Joshua Aldridge dec'd, also to allot the widow of said decedent her dower in the personal and real estate of said decedent by leave to submit the following report contained in this paper as the appraisement of said estate, also that we have allotted to widow as her dower in the slaves Cyng at \$450.00, by Harriette at \$250. Charlotte at \$175. Phillip at \$200, also 200 acres of the land as per surveyor returned by the county surveyor marked A and made a part of this said report for H. Christman Jasper Griffing Saml. Hancock

The following is the survey referred to in the above reports Surveyed for William Hogan Son of Joshua Aldridge dec'd. 200 acres of land allotted to the widow of said dec'd as her dower and bounded as follows viz. Beginning at a large gum in the field, thence N 25° W 35 poles to a stone thence N 42° W 62 poles to a stone at the North West corner of a peach Orchard, thence S 77° W 24 1/2 poles to the river, thence up the river N 4° E 85 poles, S 25° E 46 poles to a stone, thence S 45° E 47 poles to a stone, thence at 75° E 25 1/2 poles to a poplar at the West side of the field, thence S 65° W 33 1/2 poles to the beginning - 5th March 1833
