We the undersigned Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Jedamine County at their Dec Term 1829 to settle with Richd Woods & Administrator to the estate of Thomas Garnett Decd we have met this 16th day of Jan 1830 and examined the acts and vouchers relative to said estate and report as follows (viz) We find the amount of sale as per bill to be \$182.30 in the hands of the admr

Money collected and paid over as per vouchers \$182.30 cents also we find the Widow and several of the Legates charged on the sale bill to the amt of \$15.14 cents amounting in all to the sum of \$197.44 which is now deducted from the sum of \$452.30/14.37 leaves a balance in the hands of the Admr of \$254.86 cents Commission allowed the Admr of \$22.81 cents deducted from the last mentioned sum of \$254.86 cents leaves a balance against the Admr of \$232.05 cents
