Also the heirs of my beloved son Andrew Francey after deducting out thirteen dollars and fifty cents out of his part then he is to be made up equally with the rest of my children. Also I wish Joel Springfield and Mr. Wade to be my executors. Where unto I have set my hand and seal this 1st day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty three.
