The undersigned being appointed by the Jefferson County Court to settle with Richard C. Meade, W. R. Meade and John W. Randolph, Executors of David Meade dec'd, having proceeded to settle with Richard C. Meade and John W. Randolph, he came to report as follows. We find that upon a former settlement of Commissioners with Richard C. Meade & Meade on the 11th of Oct. 1830, there was a balance in his hands of \$12314.42 3/4 in notes, mortgages, and he was credited by \$8741. over paid in cash. The said executors acknowledge the receipt of \$2457. 12 3/4 since said settlement, making the sum with which he is chargeable, amount to \$15771.55 1/2. It appears that he has disbursed, including the \$8741. his credit on last settlement the sum of \$14622.62 (see vouchers \$1 to \$155 inclusive) to which we add \$1766.62 his commission on \$14732.25 the amt. of debt, except \$1032.87, the commission upon which I allow John W. Randolph & Co. and \$200 which has been allowed him for extraordinary services in traveling to Virginia and other places, and leaving his expenses, making together the sum of \$16524 1/2 the amt. of his credits. Which being deducted from \$15771.55 1/2 the amt. of debt, leaves a balance in the hands of R. C. Meade & Co. of \$156.11 according to the foregoing account.

It appears that there was a balance in the hands of John W. Randolph & Co. former settlement of \$2457. 12 3/4, which

added to the receipt of \$12.35 since, making him chargeable with the sum of \$2470.35. We find that he has disbursed \$237.06 for vouchers \$1 to \$20 inclusive, to which add \$15.25 his commission on the amt. received, and \$24.66 allowed him for extraordinary services, making the amt. of credit \$2479.97 deducted from \$2511.36, will leave a balance in the hands of said John W. Randolph & Co. of \$698.46 (on above account). 1/10 of which is respectfully submitted to the court. 29th March 1834.
