Pursuant to an order of the Lincoln County Court
to us directed to divide the real and personal
estate of Abraham Pope Dead At William Bryan
William Crow and Thomas Bate attended on
the tract of land whereon the George Pope Son
now lives lying in the County of Lincoln and

State of Kentucky on the hanging fork, returning the
Suits of John. Myers George Martin & James Gilman
the same containing by deed three hundred and thirty
acres though by actual survey three hundred & twenty
four acres Michael Myers one of the respondents
Natives of Abraham Pope Dead Confirms the afore-
said tract of land to us as the real estate of the said
Abraham Pope accordingly after having first been legally
sworn in presence and divided the same giving
to the full brother and sister full proportions and
the half brother only half proportion that half
as much as the full brother and sister which will
fully appear by the above plat and the courses
and distances herein after mentioned

I and off and surveyed for George H. Pope in full &
Cyprian of Henry Pope deceased and half brother
of said Abraham Pope deceased the lett. A's
on the plat containing sixty four acres three four
ths of an acre and eight poles it being an eighth
part of the original tract and half as much as the
lett. C's & N. 3's containing beginning for the same
at the letter A at the plat being the original
corner at an ash and buckeye running thence with
the old line East one hundred and twenty six

six poles ten feet to two hickories standing in or
near said line thence North eighty two poles to a
stake thence west one hundred and twenty six poles
ten feet and unite it into the last line of the
whole tract and with it south eighty two poles
to the beginning at the letter A.

Take off and survey for Henry Pope infant and
orphan of Henry Pope Deceased and full brother of
the said Abraham Pope Deceased the Lot N^o 2 on the
plot containing one hundred and twenty nine

N^o 1 contains. Beginning for the same at the letter B
on the plot at an ash and Elm, being the beginning corner
of the said Henry Pope Lot N^o 2 and running from
thence with the line of Lot N^o 2 South one hundred
and fifty nine poles to a stake corner to Lot N^o 1
standing in the line of Lot N^o 2 thence running
West with Lot N^o 1 one hundred and twenty six poles
ten feet to a stake corner to Lot N^o 1 standing in
