 General Expenses to be paid at the death of my Executors for
 that purpose. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca
 Price a certain black Filly two years old at my Death and at the
 Death of my Wife four cows & calves or the value thereof
 I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah Price all my
 Estate During her natural life for her support and at her Death
 for the use of my Estate to be sold and Equally Divided among
 Eight Children namely to wit Moses Price Sarah Mary
 Samuel Price Susanah Eliza Eliza Eliza Eliza Eliza Eliza
 Isaac Price Sarah Price Sarah Price Sarah Price Sarah Price
 Son Benjamin Price ten shillings at the Death of my self & my
 I appoint my well beloved wife Sarah Price and my son Isaac

 This Indenture of Writing was forced to be the last will &
 Testament of Abraham Price deceased by the oath of David Auley
 and ordered to be certified And at a County Court held for Lincoln
 County of Lincoln the 13th day of November 1798 the same was sworn
 by the oath of Henry Auley as High Sheriff and ordered to be
 Recorded, And on the Motion of Sarah Price and Isaac Price the
 Executors above named who made Oath as the said David Auley
 with Henry Auley their security entered into and acknowledged Bond
 in the penalty of \$2000 pounds conditioned as the said David Auley
 is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in Due form
