-ham Marshal deceased among his Legitimates
and John Marshal William Marshal Baley
Marshal Charles Marshal & James Marshal
there being two negroes only (Curt) and named
Anthony the other copy we do allot the
negro man named Cyrus at one hundred
& twenty pounds to John Marshal William
Marshal & Baley Marshal and the negro man
named Anthony to Charles Marshal, at
seventy five pounds the ^{same} John, William
& Baley Marshal paying to Charles & James
paying to Marshal the sum of three pounds
Given under our hands this 10th day Jan^y 1804
