 remain unsold under the direction
 of my Wife Anne. During her to widow
 hood or life and at her Decease to
 be sold and the money or profits thence
 arising to be appropriated and applied to

the proper use of my youngest Children
 not named above untill made Equal
 with the three eldest and the Ballance
 if any to be equally divided amongst
 them all. As for my personal property I
 allow my joyce man Stephen to be sold
 and a Mother or Others bought with his price
 and put in the place. Also my ~~Servant~~
 Horse to be sold and his price to be applied
 to the benefit of my Wife and heirs and
 all the rest divisionally and Individually
 to remain on the place for the use and
 benefit of my Wife and Children untill
 they my S^d Children shall arrive at full
 age. if the my S^d Wife should remain
 a widow untill the youngest is of full
 age then as much to be raised from
 my Estate real and personal to be sold
 and equally divided amongst all my
 S^d Children, or their heirs I do further
 add and say that if the my S^d Wife
 Anne should marry Another Man
 I will bequeth and allow her ^{the} third of
 my Estate real and personal and no more.
