48 (Tract of Land in the County of Rock-

and my Rents which may be Due on
the Same. the other two-thirds to be
Equally Divided Between John Gilbert
and Samuel Porter. When there is
affidavit Likewise the Rent which may
become Due on the same; I pronounce
this my Last Will; Testament Given
under my hand and seal the second
Day of September Eighteen Hundred
and one.
