all men by these presents that I John
Stuart of the County of Lincoln and
Commonwealth of Kentucky being weak
in Body, though of a sound Memory
and strong understanding do make
and contain this my last will and
Testament in manner and form, as
follows (Viz) First I do with and
advise that my Burial be decent
without pomp or State, and all my
Just Debt and Funeral Charge be
paid at the discretion of my Executors
(hereafter to be mentioned. As to my
Worldly Estate I do with and Be-
queth unto my children Robert Stuart
twenty Shilling James Stuart twenty
Shillings Charles Stuart twenty
Shillings Clement Stuart twenty Shillings
& Sida Davis twenty Shillings. Each
of which Legacies to be paid by my

Executors hereafter to be named at my
Decease I do give and Bequeth unto my
Son Ayers so soon as he shall engage
in a marriage Estate or that my beloved
Wife Mary Stuart should Decease to him
and to his Heirs for Ever One Negro Boy
named George I give and Bequeth unto
my son William Stuart at my Decease
one negro girl named Villet to him and
his Heirs for Ever. I give and Bequeth
unto my son Giles Stuart one Negro girl
named Pdy at my Decease to him and
his Heirs for Ever. I give and Bequeth unto
son Washington Stuart so soon as he
shall become of age to him and his
Heirs for ever One Negro Man Dick. I
give and Bequeth unto my son
John Stuart so soon as he shall become
of age. One Negro girl named Elac to
and his Heirs for Ever to gether with
the Incresas forever. I give and Bequeth

Give my two sons Milton & Gibson, when
 not so soon as they become of age one
 Negro woman named Luck together
 with her two children Jacob & Betty
 these and their increase forever to the
 above boys Milton & Gibson and their
 heirs forever - to be Divided Equally
 between them. I Give and Bequeath
 unto my beloved wife Mary Stuart
 the profit of all my Estate until the
 term above enumerated shall arrive for
 my Children to Embrace their partic-
 ular Legacies. Likewise I do Give and
 Bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
 Stuart all the Residue of my Estate
 both Real and personal not before
 Enumerated so long as she shall remain
 in a state of widowhood, and for which
 Consideration she is to Rouse and Educate
 in a handsome manner my three sons
 Milton and Gibson Stuart and John

Stuart. I do further will and positively order
 that so soon as my beloved wife Mary Stuart
 shall decease or engage in a second Estate
 all the Residue of my estate both Real and
 personal which I have not heretofore will-
 ed Equally Divided between my Children
 Cyrus Stuart. William Stuart. John Stuart
 art. Washington. Stuart. John Stuart.
 Milton Stuart. & Gibson Stuart. Lastly
 I do appoint. constitute & ordain my two
 sons William Stuart and Washington
 Stuart Executors of this my last will
 and Testament and Revoking all other
 will or Wills Testament or Testaments by
 me heretofore made as witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my name and affixed my seal
 this Eighteenth Day of April. Eighteen hundred
 and One

Calling to mind the mortality of my
body and knowing it is once appointed
for all men to Die I do make
and Give this my Last will and
Testament. principally and first of all

I recommend my Soul to god who gave it
& my Body I recommend to the Earth to
be buried in a decent Christian manner
at the Discretion of my executor & as
touching my worldly goods wherewith
it hath please god for to bless me
within this life I give annua and
dispose in the following manner & form
(to wit) first of all I give and bequeath
unto my Loving Wife Fathia Johnson
the Plantation where I now live on
with all my house hold furniture
& farming utensils belonging there
unto I also give her my negroes man
Will & my negroes Bet. Agg. Sam. and
Sam. also my bay Horse Buck my
Bay mare & the black mare colt and
of the rest of the stock what she wants
there for to keep peaceably during her
natural life. and then to be
