granted him in due form of Law
Reserving to Agnes Kirkpatrick the
Executor named in the said Will
the privilege of hereafter qualifying
if she may think proper

This amount of \$ 450. divided into
three Shares gives to Each \$ 150 so that

Benjamin's Share charged with \$ 1.00
in favor of Jerusha and Catherine with five
pounds in favor of Jerusha - making
each equal in the Allotments
