she peaceably and quietly possess and enjoy the Land and
plantation whereon I now live together with the
Stock of all kind together with all the house hold
furniture for the use and Benefit of Raising her
small Children and for their Support and

Item I give to my Son Mark Milner and his heirs
the land and plantation whereon I now live to be
by him received at the marriage or Death of his mother
But if said Mark Milner should Die without heir
said land to be sold and the Price thereof to be Equally
Divided between all my last Children Begotten by
