Christen Hammon all my wearing apparel
Also to my loving son Jacob & Valentine Cook

no more than five shillings. Also I do
constitute and ordain Wm. Thanks my
sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament and I do hereby swallow all
and every other testaments with legacies
bequests or Executors by me in any Will
before named, ratifying this and no
other to be my last will and Testament

Susannah Cook to be her
last will & Testament
