 hundred & two Days the third That
 I Thomas Gay of Lincoln County
 & State of Kentucky, Being in sound mind
 and Memory to Dispose of my Estate, in
 manner as follows, (To Wit) First I Com-
 mit My Soul into the hands of God that
 gave it & my Body to the Dust from
 whence it came to be Buried in a se-
 cret Manner at the Discretion of my
 Executors. Secondly, I allow all my
 Lawful Debts to be Paid, & I do hereby
 constitute & ordain my sons (Alexander
 & John Gay) & John Blane to be my
 Executors. My Will is that the Estate
 of Land where I now live, to be
 Equally Divided between my son
 Thomas Gay & my son James Gay
 Only that the s^d James is to have the
 Improved part, & that the s^d Thomas

To Thomas & Samuel. I allow to Pay
 to my son James in his third fifty pounds
 I also will once Bequeath to my Daughter
 Polly all my Household furniture also my
 Black mare with the filly of S^r mare, &
 the Coll. the S^r mare is now with to be
 my son Saml when it is down. I also
 I also allow my son John Gay (if he chooses
 to stay on the plantation) to have the bene-
 fit of one half of it for three years here-
 after he supports his sister Polly & her
 stock & also the benefit of the dwelling
 house. I also desire that the rest of my
 stock Except two of my Cows & two
 Colours & One Steer. Bequeath by Will to
 Saml Gay, & also all the moveable
 property not mentioned to be sold
 for the benefit of Abraham Gay, Sam-
 uel Bailey, Elizabeth Briggs & Sarah
 Huston. It is also my desire that sixty
 three Pounds be Collected from my son.

That Gay, which he is owing me &
 it is my Will & desire that twenty five
 Pounds of the same be paid to my Daughter
 Polly & the Balance to be Divided between
 my sons Thomas & Saml Gay. Given under
