of them, do divide the real estate
of William Montgomery deceased, in
such part thereof as it may appear
convenient. Amongst his heirs and
representatives, and make report thereof
to the Court

Pursuant, to the Command of
the above order we the subscribers have
divided sundry tracts of land belonging to
William Montgomery deceased, amongst
the heirs after mentioned persons: Chil-

= aren heirs and representatives of the said
decedant, in the following manner Viz:—

Lot N^o 1. Part of the tract whereon
the said decedant resided and buried
in the following manner, to wit. begin-
ning at Daniel Hudgens corner and
running from thence, with the northern
line of the before mentioned tract 100 poles
to the corner, thence with a another line
of the said tract being also a line of
Jonathan Forbes land, one hundred &
twenty poles to a stake on the line, thence
by a line parallel to the first 80 poles
to a stake on a line of Daniel Hudgens
land, thence to the Beginning. All this to
James Montgomery.

Robert
Lot N^o 2. part of the above mentioned
tract, to Begin where the southern line
of N^o 1. crosses the road leading from
Hanford to the plantation whereon the
decedant resided, thence with the road
and

Ana lane southwardly to the big flat
Lick Creek thence a right line to the
North east Corner of Richard Gaines
Land, thence binding on Gaines line
on the line of the Land of the heirs of
Thomas Montgomery deceased, Luke
Hargiswood, Jonathan Porter & N^o 1. to
the Beginning allotted to Robert
Montgomery.

John's Lot N^o 3. part of the first men-
tioned tract, bounded by N^o 1. Daniel
Hudgens Richard Gaines and the line
of N^o 2 to the beginning allotted to
John Montgomery

William's & Nancy's Lot N^o 4 and 5 Composed of Four
thousand and sixty one Acres of Land
lying near the head of Carys Creek
Two thousand Acres on the South side
of Green River opposite the mouth of
Carys Creek and one thousand & twenty
eight Acres on the West fork of Reed
River purchased from Phineas Peyton

Allotted to William and Nancy
Montgomery

Thomas' Lot N^o 6 Composed of Two thousand
Acres of Land, out of A four thousand
tract Entered in the name of James
Barnett on Green River where the
line of Lincoln County strikes the
River, to be laid off adjoining one
thousand Acres purchased by Thomas
Montgomery the younger of Jabez Jones
who purchased the same of Thomas
Montgomery deceased to whom William
Montgomery deceased in his lifetime
Executed his bond which said 1000 Acres
the said Thomas Montgomery the young-
er has staked to take out of the before
mentioned tract; also the balance of a
tract of 2000 Acres on Carpenters Creek
after satisfying the claim of Joseph Mc-
Germack, Bristol Matthews and N^o 3 Car-
penter wife of Adam Carpenter. Lots assigned
of John Pope dec^d allotted to Thomas Montgomery

Lot No 783. Three hundred Acres more
part of the Donation of William
Montgomery deceased adjoining the land
of Alexander Blain on the South and
John Ireland on the North, lying
across the Pine Lick Creek, allotted to
Alexander & Polly Montgomery:

Lot No 4 Four hundred, thirty one
and a half Acres on the Waters of
Cory Creek, purchased of Edmund
Stephenson and for the said Edmund
Executed his bond to the said William
Montgomery deceased one hundred Acres
out of the tract adjoining Benjamin
Pettit's old Station tract after satis-
fying John Granger's Claim & this
Balance of the four hundred Acres
purchased or procured by Exchange by
William Montgomery of James Barnett
after satisfying Lot No 6 as before
mentioned and one hundred Acres

purchased of Thomas Montgomery
as before mentioned, allotted to Smith
