The Concofute Will & Testament of
William Moody a resident of the State of Ken-
tucky who deceased in Pennsylvania County
Virginia the twenty second day of October in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety four as follows (W^m) Imperma

78. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth
Moody of the State of Kentucky all and every singu-
lar of the Land goods & Chattels which I received
with or by her in right or consideration of Marriage
by her to be fully possessed and enjoyed by her & her
heirs and assigns forever Separately. I give and
bequeath to my sister Mary Moody (of the State of
Kentucky two Negroes (viz) Charles & Sue being
in possession of my wife in the State of Kentucky
to be possessed & enjoyed by her & her heirs or af-
signs forever. Also I give my said sister Ma-
ry one Horse to be of the value of twenty five
pounds Virginia Currency to be delivered to
her at her Marriage. I hereby I lend to
my honoured Mother Elizabeth Moody the
half of all & every singular of my Estate (except
the legacies above mentioned) to be by her pos-
sessed and enjoyed during her natural Life
and after her decease to be equally divided among
all my brother & Sisters together with my two
daughters Elizabeth Buford Moody & Mary
Moody. Also I give to my Mother a black horse
being now in her possession. Also I lend to my
wife

74 Wife above named at the balance of my estate to be enjoyed by her during her life or widowhood for the purpose of raising my two Daughters and after her decease or marriage I give the same to be divided equally between my said two abovementioned Daughters. And as I may have upon accounts against some of my Brothers or Sisters I will and desire that no such account shall stand good against any of them. And Lastly I appointed my Father in law Mr. William Buford my sole Executor of this my last will & Testament he being of the State of Kentucky Lincoln County.

The following Persons were called upon by the Testator in his last sickness to take notice of the above Testamentary words which was committed to writing the 23rd day of October 1794. Viz. Blanks Moody, William Easty, Settlement Wells.

Given under my hand and the seal of the County aforesaid the date above agreeable to an act of Congress passed in their second session entitled an act to prescribe the mode in which the public acts, records and judicial proceedings in each State shall be authenticated so as to take effect in every other State.
