 Robertson of the County of Lincoln being under
 the afflicting hand of Gods Providence by
 sickness and pain of Body but in my mem-
 -ory and mind in perfect soundness of thought
 be to Almighty God and as I now reflect
 on the Uncertainty of life and that I must
 yield to Death whenever God in his wisdom
 pleases I do hereby constitute and appoint
 this as my last Will and Testament Revoking
 and Disannulling all other by me heretofore
 made either In word or Writing and declare
 that this shall be taken and known by all
 men as my last Will and Testament

I first Give and Bequeath my soul to God
 my maker & Redeemer to be washed In his
 Blood and saved by his Grace In the next
 place I give and Bequeath my body to
 the Earth to be buried In a Decent manner
 as my Executors after named shall Direct
 and after my funeral Expences and Just
 Debts is Discharged I Dispose of the rest
 of my Worldly Estate as follows to wit
 I Give to my son Luke Robinson
 the land and plantation on which I now
 live with all the Improvements thereupon
 or thereto belonging with only this record
