and form as follows - First it is my Will that
all my Just Dpts be paid apoon as convenient
- I can be secondly I leave to my loving wife
Elizabeth Walker two hundred and thirty acres
of Land it being the Plantation (whereon I now
live together with four Negroes Daniel, Beck,
Anthony, & Easter and all my Stock of Horses
cattle Dogs and all my Household Furniture
Item I give to my two sons Jesse Walker &
David Walker a Bond on Jacob Miers &
John Whites for a certain Tract or parcel of
Land containing fourteen hundred fifty
acres to be equally Divided according to qua-
lity and quantity, I also give to my son
Jesse Walker two Negroes Peter & Daemong
and I give to my son David Walker two

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lity and quantity, I also give to my son
Jesse Walker two Negroes Peter & Daemong
and I give to my son David Walker two

Negroes as by & join to them and their heirs,
forever. Item I give to my Daughter Betty
Walker two negroes Bid & Lucy to her and
her heirs forever. Item I give to my Daugh-
ter Betsy two negroes Juno & Abner all
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give
to my Daughter Susanna Walker two Negroes
Dione & Betty all to her heirs forever.
And as I have money due to me for binges
and elsewhere it is my Will and desire
that as soon as they can be collected or as much
as will purchase four Negroes that my
Executors purchase four Negroes for my two
youngest Daughters These Walker and Rhoda
Walker to be of equal value to the Negroes
given to the rest of my Daughters to them
and their heirs forever.

And as I have several tracts of land lying
in different places unmentioned in my Will
It is my Desire that they be sold for the best
price my Executors can conveniently get
and the money due me when collected what
is over paying my Debt and purchasing the
above said four Negroes for my two youngest
Daughters to be equally divided among
my children and wife considering her
to have a child's part and it is my

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Will Desire that after my wife's death
that the Negroes and Land lent to her be
Equally Divided among all my children
and lastly I constitute and Ordain Jesse
Walker and David Walker Executors of my
loving wife Elizabeth Walker Executrix of
this my last will and Testament In Witness
whereof I have set my hand and affixed my
seal this 10th Day of June 1703

This Will was proved by the Oaths of Marcellus
Nash and John Embree Witnesses thereto
and Ordered to be Recorded, and on the motion
of Jesse Walker and Elizabeth Walker one of
the Executors and the Executrix therein named
a Certificate is granted them for obtaining
a Probate thereof in due form Whereupon
the said Jesse Walker and Elizabeth Walker
made Oath and Executed and acknow-
ledged Bond as the Law Directs

that the Plantation thus left to him in this Will shall be sold and the money arising therefrom to be Disposed of as follows: One third part thereof to Hannah one third part thereof to Sally and the remaining third part to be Divided Between my Daughter Betty four Children and all the Remainder of my Estate not Disposed of in this my Will to be Disposed of by said power: Whilse it is my Will and Desire that if my son Luke should not choose to live upon this his Plantation, Willse to him that he may sell and Dispose of it and purchase Elsewhere to suit him self and to his liking and may Dispose of the same in what ever way he may Judge Expedient Except that his sister Hannah while single shall Enjoy the said Plantation or the advantages arising therefrom with her Brother Luke. In the same proportion as she is Entitled to this on which I live and set forth in this Will and I Do hereby nominate and appoint my son Luke Robinson and William Fitch as Executors to carry into Effect after my Decease this my last Will and Testament according to the true Intent and Literal meaning

thereof as Witness my hand and Seal with my Seal this twentieth day of October 1792
