April 1793 I Isaac Hamptell being very sick and
In low condition but of perfect mind and memory
and calling to mind the mortality of my body and
that it is appointed for all men once to die Do in
the first place recommend my soul into the hands of
God that gave it nothing Doubting but that I
shall receive the same again by the mighty power
of God at the General resurrection, and as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith God has been pleased
to bless me with in this life, I Give Devise &
Dispose of ^{the same} the same in the
manner and form following - That is to say.
Imprimis, I Do hereby allow all my just debts
to be settled and paid out of my Estate. 2^{dly} I Give
and Devise to my brothers viz. Charles James &
William, The Tract of Land now called Whitley's
(if Obtained by Law) In the following manner to
my younger Brother William eight hundred
acres in the middle of said Tract, including
where Whitley now lives to my Brother Edward
and James, Three hundred acres each to be divided
at each end of the 5^d Survey viz. Where Davis
& Hammond now lives, and if either end should
exceed the Other in Value, The balance to be
paid
