the same Portion of this World's goods that it hath pleased
God to bless me with I make this my last will and testament
Renouncing all other made heretofore I first of all give my
Soul to God that gave it and my Body to the Grave to be buried
at the discretion of my Executors and after my death I give
Give and bequeath as follows: I leave my real estate to be

as much of my land as will pay my debts and the balance of
my estate that I now or hereafter shall possess I give and
bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife during her natural life
or Widowhood and after her decease or her Marriage to be equally
divided between all my Children then alive and I appoint
my beloved Wife, Martin, Isaac and Edward Tamby to be
the Executors of this my last Will and Testament sealed
