April 1st 1873 I now lying on a sick bed and it
appears well shortly before the close of death I therefore name
my friend Edward Gathers to give me a document bearing witness
to the husband and of my estate I bequeath to my brother Thomas
Geller two hundred and fifty acres of land bearing from
all town settlement coming from his lower corner and running
down Salt River on both sides for quantity I also bequeath to
William Geller son of Thomas Geller my horse I also be-
queath to my brother Thomas Geller four head of cattle also
my plow and other tools I bequeath also what salt is due to
me from James McQueen Junior one bushel and Matthew
Giffis three bushels also I bequeath to Elizabeth Gathers one cow
red and black also I leave to my brother Thomas Geller my
Rifle gun and shot bag and cloak over this being my last
Will and Testament so having set my hand and seal
