In the Name of God amen I John
Tucker of Lincoln and District of Kentuc-
ky being through the abundant mercy
and goodness of God: though weak in body
yet of a sound and perfect Understanding
and memory do constitute and appoint
this my last will and Testament and desire
it to receive by all as such. In witness
I most Humbly begueth my soul to God
my maker beseeching his most Gracious
acceptance of it through the the all suffi-
cient merit and mediation of my most
Compassionate redeemer Jesus Christ
who gave himself to be an Atonement for my
sins and is able to save to the utter-
most all that come unto God by him seeing
he ever liveth to make Intercession for them

and who I trust will not reject me: a returning
Punient sinner when I come for him for money
In this Hope and confidence I render up my
soul with Comfort Humbly beseeching the most
blessed and Glorious Trinity our God most Holy
most merciful and Gracious to prepare me for
the time of my Departation and then to take me
to himself into that Peace and rest and Incom-
parable felicity which he has prepared for those
that fear and love his Holy Name Amen blessed
be God In witness I give my body to the Earth
from whence it was taken in full appearance of its
Resurrection from thence at the last day as for
my burial I desire it may be decent without
Pomp or State at the Discretion of my dear
wife and my Executors hereafter named who I
doubt not will manage it with all requests
Prudence as to my worldly Estate I will and
Positively Order that all my debts be paid
Them I will and Order that all my Estate
be valued at my decease (all but my

negro Boy named Stoney aged sixteen years
last February which I allow my wife to possess
during her life or widowhood but if she marries
I allow and Order my Executors that the said
negro be hired out by my Executors untill he
arrives at the age of thirty one at which time
I order him to be set free and his wages collect-
ed and Equally divided Between my wife
& five Children) and my wife to keep
possession of the same untill my youngest
Child comes of age at which time I order that
each Child shall receive an Equal Part
of the same together with my wife that is
the true Estimate of the value of said
Estate to be divided into six Equal Parts
and my wife to receive one and each Child
one of said Parts and if any of my Children
doth marry before ^{the} youngest Child comes
of age and my Executors think convenient
to let them have any thing belonging to said
Estate I do Order that they receive it

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according to the value thereof in part of their own
legacies that is due to them at times the youngest
Child comes of age and I do appoint and constitute
Edmund Powell William Patton and my wife
Executors and Trustees of this my last Will and
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this 9th day of August

1790
