pting But I shall receive the same again
at the Resurrection in life and glory and
as for the things of this life wherewith
I am blessed I give and Dispose in the
following manner to wit I gave and
Bequeath to my three sons Peter and

Henry and The Willey one Dollar Each
and the rest and whole and all and Every
Other Part of my Estate and all my bonds
and other accounts I gave and bequeath
to my Eldest son John Willey whom I appo
int the Executor to pay all my Just
Debts and receive all Debts due to me
And this to be my Last Will and Testame
nt and all other to be void and of no
Effect Witness my hand and Seal
January the 3rd 1792
