I Joseph Langford of the County of Lincoln and State of Virginia do the sixth day of September in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty three make this my last Will and Testament.

I do give and bequeath to wit my my dearly beloved wife the whole use and benefit of what slaves, goods and Chattels I may be possessed of at my decease to be at her disposal during her life or widowhood my Lawful Debts being first ~~paid~~ discharged, and at her death to be equally divided among my children but if she marries one third to be devised to her according to the apprehension of the other two thirds to be disposed of as above I also if any of my Children should die without their such share is to be equally divided among my other Children also to give my wife the benefit of my Land during her widowhood but in case of marriage to give two thirds thereof to my son Joseph if he dies before he is come to years of maturity the whole of it to be reserved for supporting of him and my youngest Daughter Sarah also to give the whole of my Land to my son Joseph and his heirs forever but if he dies without his part it is equally among my other Children and their heirs also to hereby constitute make and ordain my wife James Brown the sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament

And solemnly menly do allow and revoke all other Wills Testaments or bequests by me made or given and signing Confirming this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
