 for pardon and remission of all my sins through the
 merits and sufferings of my Saviour Jesus Christ my body I yield to the Earth to be buried
 in such Christian like manner as my Executors herein after
 named shall see meet and as to such worldly Estate as I
 hath pleased God to bestow on me I give devise and bequeath
 the same in manner and form following First I give and
 devise to my son Samuel my right of land for serving a
 Soldier to the King in the year one thousand seven hundred
 and seventy eight to him and his heirs for ever. Item I do
 give and devise to my five children namely Samuel Thomas
 James Jesse and John all my Estate to be equally to be
 divided between them when my son John comes of age

to him and his heirs for ever. Item I do give to my wife and eldest wife
 Mary all my Estate for serving her Widowhood or married life and
 if my wife Mary should marry or die before my son John comes
 of age that my Children not being of age be put to the charge
 up with such of my friends as my Executor in his discretion shall
 see meet. And lastly I do appoint my Brother Hugh Henry Ex-
 ecutor of this my last Will and Testament Revoking and making
 null and void all other Wills by me heretofore made declaring
 this and no other to be my last Will and Testament in witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirteenth day
 of December In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
 and seventy nine
