spoken by him on the day that he died in the presence
of those to the underneath subscribers.

I wish my wife to keep all the corn, we have and
Cakes and live hives and leave to her first choice out of
my stock, all the horse stock of 4000, and the
young one pair of Jers live straight a shorn plough
and an one horse barshane, that all my horses be sold
and a chunk of a horse be bought for her (also the ones
The plantation must be rented, part is rented already
for 5000 and the balance be rented out - All the
rest of my stock and waggons to be sold at twelve
months credit the 1000 of a stock bought of Mr.
Bridges to be sold and a quantity of salt that is owing
to me to be sold at twelve months credit likewise the
stock to be sold on the 15 day of May or as soon after
May court as possible.

There above is in substance what was heard this said George
Campbell say at his own house on the 16th day of
this present month and do this day came same to be
written witness our hands and seals this seventeenth
day of March 1815

In the Name of God Amen. I Owen Stratton of the
County of Logan State of Kentucky for some time being
sick and weak but in perfect mind and memory thanks
be given unto god looking into mine the mortality of my body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men here to die do
make and ordain this my last will and Testament (1815)
First of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty god that give it and my body I recommend to
the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the
direction of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general
Resurrection I will receive this same again by the mighty
powers of god as touching my worldly estate (whereunto it
hath pleased god to bless me in this life) I give devise and bequeath
of the same in following manner and form.

I Give and bequeath my land to Benjamin Stratton Mary
Elizabeth Stratton and my sister Elizabeth Chambers

Also all my stock horses corn farming tools and other
articles not recited to be sold at a credit of 12 months
the money to be divided equally divided between the above
Elizabeth Stratton and Elizabeth Chambers both of the County
Virginia Pittsylvania County Agent sealed and Published and
pronounced and Declared by the said Owen Stratton as his
last Will and Testament in presence of us two in presence
of each other have hereunto subscribed our names &c
