

This my Codicil to be annexed to my will dated the 20th of September 1813 I give and bequeath to son Robertus having a bond that I have an Samuel Caldwell for one hundred dollar horse in lieu of the good Oak tract of land mentioned in my will also my bond horse in lieu of the bond Bond of fifty dollars that I got from said Robertus an Andrew Also give and bequeath to my wife my bay 1st M. shaw mare in lieu of s Brown horse I also release my daughter Locky Blevins from the twenty dollar fine year as stated in my will also I give and bequeath to my brother Chatham having one hundred dollar horse to be paid by said Locky Blevins out of that part of my estate that I have willed to her at the death of her mother and it is also my will and desire that all my other estate both real personal and mixed that is not mentioned in my will or this my Codicil be equally divided between my living children at the death of my wife whereof I have written for my hand and Affixed my seal this day of December 1813. 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James Barton of the County of Logan and State of Kentucky being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as followeth (Wiz) I first recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it and my body to the dust to be buried in a decent Christian manner like at the direction of my executors and to dispose of my property as followeth (Wiz) and first I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary my tract of land and my two mares a grey and a bay with all my household furniture and plantation utensils with two white Cows I likewise bequeath to my daughter Barbary Smith One bay Colt and to my daughter Nancy my Black colt. I likewise give to my son Reuben the share of my Bay mare colt that she is now with I likewise give unto my son William the share of my Grey mare colt that she is now with I likewise bequeath unto the Rest of my children to each a Cow Head and to my beloved wife my hogs and all sums of money due unto me to be at her disposal beside the tract of land I now live On I likewise choose my truly friend William Duncan my executor and my wife Mary my executrix to this my last will and testament the which I have signed with my hand and seal this twenty fourth of March One thousand eight hundred and four signed and sealed in the presence of
