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In the name of God Amen I Thomas Harris of Logan
County State of Kentucky planter being sick and weak
in body but of sound mind and memory thank God for
the same knowing the uncertainty of the transitory
world to make this my last will and testament in
manner and form following to wit: I give and bequeath
my soul into the hands of the almighty God hoping for
my through Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my body to
the Church to be decently buried at the direction of
Executors hereafter mentioned and what I lately Estate
it pleased God to bestow on me I give and bequeath in
the manner and form following to wit: I desire
is that all my Just Debt be paid & I leave my
youngest son Joseph Harris all that tract of Land con-
taining one hundred Acres situated in said county and
including the house that I now live in with rights
and lying in Tennessee state Robertson City adjoining
the above hundred acres and also two acres of a three hundred
and twenty acre survey in Tennessee state Robertson County
also adjoining the above hundred acres being above the
spring that I now make use of on the bank of the river
running East and north for complement and also to have
the first Coll that that should come from the mare
I now am in possession of and also twenty dollars to be
paid in cash to be raised out of my property. I desire
that my daughter Merondy shall have twenty dollars
cash to be raised out of my property. I desire that my
son Thomas Francis shall have one hundred acres of Land
lying in Logan County it being the place where
