by Michael Mitchell & Evan McPherson. And I do desire that
my will above mentioned made on the sixth of the present
month shall stand and remain as my last will & Testament except

all my property both real and personal during her
natural life under this provision that she give my
Children a reasonable education and it is my Will that
at her death my lands together with all my property be
sold and the proceeds equally divided among all my children
