I Jesse all Combs of the County of Logan and Commonwealth of Kentucky being in a low state of health but of a sound mind and Memory and being advanced in life have thought proper to settle my Temporal business and for that purpose do constitute this my last Will and Testament Revoking all others - First, I desire that my funeral be after the order of the believers with whom I am united in my faith. Next I order that all my just debts if any be paid; And as I have heretofore sold all my lands and some other property for which I have obligations; I order the amount of my estate both sold and unsold to be disposed of as follows by Executors hereafter named (To Wit) I give to my wife Sally all Combs seven hundred dollars in a note Executed by George Rankin John all Combs, and Samuel G. White on the sixth day of July 1812 payable on or before the fourth day of July 1822. (Item) I give to my daughter Eliza

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McClellan four hundred dollars in a note Executed by
George Rankin, Johnell Combs, and Samuel G. Whyte, on
the sixth day of July 1812 payable on or before the fourth day
of July 1818 And my assignment on the Back of said
Note on the seventh day of July 1812 -- And as I
have heretofore allotted to my son Johnell Combs two hun-
dred and fifty acres of land which I purchased of John
Rankin and the obligation I had on John Rankin
for a little I have this day assigned over to my son John
as his part of my estate by his giving his notes for two
hundred dollars. (Item) I give to my daughter
Maryell Combs five hundred and fifty dollars in a
Note Executed by George Rankin Johnell Combs
and Samuel G. Whyte on the sixth day of July
1812 payable the fourth day of July 1822 and my
assignment on the back of said Note the twentieth day of
July 1812. (Item) I give to my son Jesse Combs
eight hundred dollars in three Notes two of
which were Executed by George Rankin Johnell Combs
and Samuel G. Whyte on the sixth day of July 1812
One of which was for seven hundred dollars and the
other for fifty dollars both payable on or before the fourth
day of July 1822. - The other Note Executed by John
ell Combs on the twentieth day of October 1812 payable
on or before the fourth day of July 1822 -

The Remainder of my Estate I give to the so-
ciety of Believers - or people called Shakers with
whom I live and stand united in my faith as a
compensation for the support and kindness I have
received since becoming a member of said Society

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(Item) I will that my Black people viz, Leah, Elizabeth, Rachel
and Elizabeth be and remain with the Society of Believers where
they now are during their Natural lives provided they obey
the faith and conform to the rules of said society but for
they the said Leah, Elizabeth, Rachel, and Elizabeth or either
of them should not conform or obey as aforesaid then it is my will
that my Executors or trustees for said society dispose of them
according to their best understanding to any person or per-
sons of known humanity - And for the better Execution
of this my Last Will and Testament I do hereby
appoint my son Johnell Combs and Samuel G. Whyte
my Executors in confidence that they will faithfully
discharge the trust reposed in them -
