Agreeable to an order of the Logan County Court to us
directed we have proceeded to settle Reza Long here
down — N 103 One hundred and Ninety Eight and
58 poles bounded as followeth beginning at a white
beetnut and ash standing on the west bank of McKee
Creek running N 60 W 152 poles to a cedar and Mulberry
N 30 E 25 poles to a hickory N 60 W 52 poles to a dogwood
and hickory 2 black oaks S 30 W 160 poles to two white oaks
S 42 E 103 poles to a poplar S 44 E 100 poles to a hemlock
& South Maple standing on the west bank of the creek
down said Creek with the meanders of the creek to the
beginning including the plantation and buildings Also one
negro man by the name of Jonathan also one negro
woman by the name of Rachel Spicers under our
hands this 30th Decem. 1815
