 of my father's estate I acknowledge this to be my last
 will and testament which I have signed sealed

In the name of God amen I Thomas Anderson of the
 County of Kentucky and County of Logan do make and
 declare the following for to be my last will and testament that
 I resign myself to God who gave it and my body to be
 decently entred in Salem Church burial Ground and
 as to the Good things of this world that God in his
 kind providence has blessed me with I give and bequeath
 them in the manner following to wit in the
 first place I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mar-
 garet the dwelling house which I now live and the
 Out house appertenant thereto and the whole of the
 household furniture during her lifetime and thus far to be
 equally divided between my five children to wit William
 Henry, Samuel and Rachel I give and bequeath to
 my said Wife Margaret and my wife during her life
 Reserving her income to be disposed of for the benefit of
 the above mentioned five children and further I give &
 bequeath to my said wife Margaret the whole of my stock
 of cattle during her life for the raising and support of the family
 and after her decease far to be equally divided between my five
 children above mentioned likewise I give and bequeath to my
 wife Margaret the whole of my stock of Hogs
 during her life for the support of the family and at her decease
 far to be equally divided between the above mentioned children
 Secondly I give and bequeath to my five children above
 mentioned to each one thirty pounds any one of the five
 choosing to pay the other three thirty pounds as an equal
 and to their part of the land shall have the Right to
 the Land and if none of the said five children

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Should choose to pay the above mentioned Liabilities then the
Land to be sold by my executors for the highest price that can
be had and the price equally divided between the said
children but the Plantation is to be Reserved during the
life of my wife for the support of the family thereby I give
and bequeath to my beloved son William James Henry &
Samuel the whole of my farming tools and implements to be
continued on the farm during the life of my wife Margaret
and then to be equally divided between the said boys
permanently I give and bequeath to my beloved son James my
riding Saddle - I give and bequeath to my beloved
son Henry my Rifle Gun - Further it is my wish that
my just debts be discharged out of the present crop of corn
and if there is a surplus that it go to the use of the family
and that all things that is now on the farm required
for the consumption of the family be applied to that purpose
The above I declare to be my last will and testament
I constitute and appoint my well beloved son William and
James my executors for to see that it be strictly fulfilled
as witness my hand and seal this 14th March 1800

men are appointed once to die doth by these presents make
his my last will and testament First of all I leave my soul
to god and my body to the ground in hopes of its glorious resurrec-
tion thro the merits of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
and all the worldly goods that it hath pleased the almighty
to bestow upon me I leave in the following manner I give
and bequeath to my dear beloved wife a full maintenance
from the land and ^{estate} during her life as a widowhood -

I then give and bequeath to my son James and John all the
land which I am in possession of also an equal part with the
income of my estate with my daughters and do hereby constitute
and appoint John Russell Samuel M. Cracker and Henry Manzy
to execute this my last will and testament I then give and bequeath
to my daughter Mary Russell all that part of my land lying west
of the Spring Branch her the said Mary Russell not having
any part of my moveable property with the rest of my daughters
into which will and testament I do hereby set my hand this 10th
