Britton of this said County of Logan and to the survivors or survivor of them in trust for the payment of my debts and the use ^{support and} of my wife and children with full power and discretion to sell and dispose of the same or any part thereof and apply the same or the proceeds of any sale thereof after payment of my debts to the comfortable support & maintenance of my wife and family and education of my children - and I do hereby constitute and appoint my said friends Montford, Brantlett, and Britton the Guardians of my son Edwin particularly enjoining it upon them to afford him every opportunity of a liberal Education which the means of funds placed in their hands by the trust aforesaid are competent to - and it is my particular will and desire that my said friends Montford, Brantlett, and Britton should have the care and direction of the education of my said son and that all expenses necessary for his education as a private scholar may charge upon all the property hereinafore written & devised to my said trustees - I do moreover request of my said trustees to concur as far as may be convenient and practicable the wishes

of my wife and affections every indulgence and
accommodation which they may think reasonable
with the duties of their said trust - and I do
hereby constitute and appoint my said trustee the
execution of this my last will and testament -
