 this my last will & testament First I will my soul to the Almighty
 God and my body to its mother dust and as to my worldly es-
 tate I bequeath as followeth to wit, I give to Robert Foster
 John & Long Thomas Foster & Edmund Curo in Trust for the
 sole use of my son Edmund Foster and his heirs forever the
 tract of land whereon I now live which contains two hundred
 acres also one negro boy named Jim about fifteen years
 of age Also all my stock of cattle horses hogs, sheep house
 hold & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils except
 those herein after will disposed of It is my express will
 that my son have the use & benefit of the abovesaid land &
 property during his life and at his death to descend to his
 legal heirs equally It is also my will that my two negroes
 Martin & Betty have their liberty at my death as it is my
 will that they be emancipated - I give my son John
 Curo one horse one saddle one barrel mace with a flaxen man
 & tail - I give to my son Thomas Foster my three vols of
 Lects Gills Exposition on the new testament - I give my
 daughter Hannah Stubbs my silver watch - which was
 my wife deires in her life time I give my grand daughter
 Rosa James one feather Bed I give my son Edmunds daughter
