do make this my last will and testament as follows
first I do submit my body to the earth from whence
it came and my soul unto the hands of God who
gave it me blessing in the resurrection of the body
I through Jesus Christ Our Lord of what property
it has pleased God to bless me with my body to
be buried in a Christian like manner and all debts
due to be paid and also all my just debts to the
balance I do will and bequeath as follows first
to my beloved and only son William the land I
now live on being two hundred acres and also

keeper that that was given to him by his Uncle
William Thompson also I will settle to
my beloved wife when the household and bid in
furniture and animals cattle and hogs one
horse provided at the same time the my wife it
is to be understood is to pay or discharge a note
of twenty dollars which I give to William
Thompson out of her part of the property
also it is to be understood that it is my will that
my third son is to have the privilege of making her
maintenance of the plantation or land during
his life provided he remains a widow but not
if he takes a companion or money also
I do appoint my beloved brother Samuel
Thompson Executor of this my last will and
testament Also in full testimony of this being
my last will and testament I do here by sign my
hand and seal this the eleventh of February in
the year of our Lord 1819
