eighth one thousand Eight hundred and Eighteen
Thomas Barnet of Logan County and State of Kentucky
being at present sick but of perfect sound mind and
memory doth think proper to make this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all others, as followeth
First I give and recommend my Soul to God Who give it
and my body to the Earth to be buried at the direction
of my Executors, as to my worldly Estate I give and dispose
of in the following manner — Item 1st I give and be-
queath to my son John Barnet one negro woman named
Frank — Item 2^d I give to my son James, C. Barnet
and Negro boy named Bob — Item 3rd I give to my
Daughter Elizabeth now Elizabeth Shannon one negro girl,
named Jimmy which negro I give to the said Elizabeth
and her body hers forever — Item 4th I give to my granddaugh-
ter Liza Barnet who is the daughter of my son William
Barnet Decd. one negro girl named Aggy and one bed
and furniture — Item 5th it is my perfect will and de-
= sire that my negro man Tom now by the name of
yellow Tom shall be a free man at my death — Item 6th
it is my wish and desire for my negro woman Susky
to live with one of my children as long as she may live
or to live with the one she may make choice of living with
or to live with them all at times if it should be
her choice — Item 7th to the heirs of my Daughter Lucy
who desec^d this life Lucy Sanders I give in addition

to what I have heretofore given now give one Dollar —
Item 8th to the heirs of my Daughter Mary who desec^d this
life Mary Headen I give in addition to what I have
heretofore given now give one Dollar — Item 9th to
my two grandsons Adams Sanders and Thomas Fields,
the sons of my son William Barnet I give in addition
to what I have heretofore given, now give one Dollar
each — Item 10th it is my wish and desire for all
the balance of my Estate after paying all my just debts
shall be Equally divided between my three children, John
Barnet James C. Barnet, and, Elizabeth Shannon to be
divided in any way they may think proper between them
— Item 11th I appoint my two sons John & James, C.
Barnet my Executors this given under my hand and
seal the day and date aforesaid in the presence of

at my, the time of death to be specifically paid
I have well and bequeath one hundred dollars to each
of my Sisters & Nancy C. Prince wife of E. C. Prince
& Sarah Ellen to be paid to them by my Mother Anne
Allen whenever they may find it most convenient to
herself in the management of my estate & that if
my dear father who being compellable to pay it on
my part thereof if it by any process of Law and
if my attempt shall be made to coerce the payment
by process of Law such attempt shall amount to a
forfeiture of the same & the part of her making
such attempt shall be equally divided between
my following Legacies & by of it Sister Sarah & Ellen
may at her pleasure either appropriate the whole of
the said bequest to her own use or divide it as she

may think fit among his youngest children and I bless them often my wish is that it is my will and desire that all my property with the exception of the one hundred dollars real personal and mixed in possession or remainder or reversion devised or bequeathed or otherwise in action or possession money or claim or interest in property or money be equally divided among my following Brothers, Sisters, Nephews, Sons and Daughters, William Allen, Parker Allen, Caroline Allen, Harriet Allen, Mary Elizabeth Allen, Ellen Allen. It is my will and desire that no sale be made of any of my property and that it remain in the possession of my mother, Anna Allen until my said Brothers & Sisters arrive at the age of the boys one year or marry at which time each of them have option to buy or hire for or her share of my estate according to the age be worth my mother will being required to pay interest to any of them on the money which I may be obliged for or any thing for the use of the property when they acknowledge as apt to return in possession. And it is my will & desire that my friend John Allen who my mother Anna Allen take upon themselves the execution of my will will do my Executor & Executor at last time, whereof I have hereto let my home and let this 23rd day of June in the year 1817.
