 my assets also all my horses and cattle and pigs &c and
 farming utensils and all my crop of any kind whatsoever also
 prior negroes to wit Phillis Amy Phillis and Lucinda in the
 state of Louisiana and all other species of property now and
 this Court but it is my mind & will that the said people they
 shall pay age my said debts that is unpaid to them under my
 & that this 4th day of Sept 1820
