County and State of Kentucky, being and sick and weak
in body but of sound mind considering the certainty
of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof
being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be
better prepared to leave this world when it shall
please God to call me hence as therefore make and
publish this my last will and testament in maner
and form following that is to say first and forso-
pally I commit my soul into the hands of all-
mighty God and my body to the Earth to be decently buried
at the direction of my friends and after my debts

funeral charges are paid I Give and bequeath as follows
I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Anna Boone all
my Estate both real and personal during her natural
life in case she remains a widow should she Inter marry with
any other person then when that case I Give my will and
wish the she should take her one third part as the
Law gives to the balance on the other two thirds to be
divided of which hereafter directed at the death or
Inter marriage of my wife as the case may be it is my
wish and will that all my children should share
Equal in the following manner and way I have
given my four eldest children the following sums
son Tho^s Boone has received one Hundred and fifty
Dollars my Daughter Susannah each will has the two
hundred and twenty Dollars my Daughter Lucy Kerley
has received Ninety Dollars and my Daughter Bin
thaan Grubbs has received Seventy Dollars my other
nine children by name Samuel Boone Squire Boone
Ira Boone Josiah Boone Leodomia Boone Higgerson
Boone Lucy Boone Nancy Boone & Polly Boone now it is
my will and wish that when any Distribution is made
it should be done in the following way the nine last
named children first to receive Seventy Dollars each
which will be Equal to what Binthaan Grubbs has
received then the same nine children are Anthon
Grubbs to receive twenty Dollars each which will
make them Equal to what Lucy Kerley has received then
the same nine children and Binthaan Grubbs &
Lucy Kerley to receive Sixty Dollars each which
will make them Equal to what Tho^s Boone has
received then the same nine children together
with Binthaan Grubbs Lucy Kerley and Tho^s Boone to
receive one Hundred and twenty Dollars each
which will make them all Equal to Susannah
Boekrell afterwards all Distributions to be Equally
made amongst all of the above named children it is
further my wish that if my wife Anna Boone
should during the time she occupies the whole of my
Estate give to any one of my children any thing they
may particularly need that she in that case take
their receipts for the same which receipts have be
