 body but sound in mind and memory do make & constitute
 this my last will & testament that I will my soul to the Almighty
 God and my body to its mother dust and as to my worldly es-
 tate I acquath as followeth to wit, I give to Robert Foster
 John S. Long, Thomas Foster & Edmund Curo in Trust for the
 sole use of my son Edmund Foster and his heirs forever the
 tract of land whereon I now live which contains two hundred
 acres also one negro boy named Jim about fifteen years
 of age also all my stock of cattle horses, hogs, sheep, house
 hold & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils except
 those herein otherwise disposed of. It is my express will
 that my son have the use & benefit of the abovesaid land &
 property during his life and at his death to descend to his
 legal heirs equally. It is also my will that my two negroes
 Martin & Betty have their liberty at my death as it is my
 will that they be emancipated. I give my son John
 Curo one horse, Foster one sorrel mare with a flaxen mane
 & tail. I give to my son Thomas Foster my three vols of
 Lects. Gills Expositions on the new testament. I give my
 daughter Hannah Mullblossfield my silver watch - which was
 my wife dears in her life time I give my grand daughter
 Rozza James one feather Bed. I give my son Edmunds daughter
 Rozza one feather Bed. Having ^{hereafter} given my children
 Patsy Anthony Robert Sally Rozza & Elizabeth part of my
 property It is not now for the want of Effectors that they
 are not bequeathed any part. Hereby revoking all
 other wills ever made by me. In Testimony whereof I have
