body but of sound and disposing mind and
able memory calling to mind the mortality of my body
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last will and testament
viz, first I bequeath my land to the hand of God
who gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian
manner at the discretion of my friend Solomon and
as touching such worldly estate whereof I have
pleased God to bestow on me with I do dispose of as
follows viz, I give the payments of my just debts
and funeral charges I am in I will bequeath to
my beloved wife Catharine White my Negro
Boys, Sarah, Ben, Fred and Solomon & Solomon
together with the plantation during his natural
life and all the stock of horses cattle pigs sheep
&c. I give charge to the said that David Snow ~~Shawn~~
viz a brown horse docted with all the household
and kitchen furniture and the present crop of
every description added at her death to be divided
as follows viz to my son Thomas White give my
negro man Lewis to my son Lewis White & give
I acquit the plantation or tract of land
whereon I now live together with my negroes Bob
Squab and Solomon and the said to my son
sonny White and the sum of fifty dollars
and to my daughter Polly White fifty dollars and
to my daughter Nancy Bailey fifty dollars to be
paid at his own discretion and to my son John White
I give my negro boy & Simon and to my son Jonathan
White I give my negro woman and add, it is my
will that each of the last named John &
Jonathan have one bed and furniture and the
whole of my stock of horses cattle pigs sheep &
furniture together with my household and kitchen
furniture at the discretion of my wife Catharine
to be equally divided between my three sons John
Lewis & David according to the bequest thereof
set forth before, I am & counter that I have given
to son Lewis White several more than and equal
share of my property therefore I will allow him
only forty dollars which he was owing me last I
do hereby constitute and appoint my son David
White Charles to Robert Coleman of the my last will
and testament and do hereby revoke and disannul
all former wills & testaments volitions and confirming
this to be my last will & testament to witness

whereof I have heretofore let my hand seal the
ninth day of June 1824
