and also my House hold & kitchen furniture and stock of every kind
during her natural life and at her death it is my will and desire
that whatever of the above property that may be remaining shall be

equally divided between all my children to wit Eliza Richardson, George
R. Wilson, Isaac L. Wilson, Jane Brockmire, Nancy West, Thos. Brown
Fanny Lowery, Sally Rice, Eliza Clark, & Sarah Wilson and all the
remaining property to be at this time equally divided between all my
children above named after paying all my last & do hereby bequeath it to my
wife that my daughter Sarah Wilson shall have seventy five dollars
in the further more than the rest in the form of a Horse, Cow & Bed, as the
rest of the children have all received these, and it is my will and desire
that my son in Law, James Lowery shall not have it in his power
to make away with that portion of my estate that may in the division
fall to my daughter Fanny Lowery but that the portion that falls
to her shall remain for her keeping in the hands of my Executor and
the said Fanny may draw from the Executor the interest & value of
said property or money as it may fall due & continue to draw it
to be understood that with the said portion of Fanny Lowery to remain
in the hands of my Executor until they can make such other arrange-
ments for the future of said property unto said Fanny Lowery &
her children as shall then to have the benefit of it, I also contain

my trusty friends, Aaron Talbot & Joseph Richardson & Thomas Talbot
my Executors for the performance of this my last will this 31st of
March 1827
