

Sheweth In the name of God Amen I Thomas Ellorwood of the County of
that the State of Kentucky being of a sound mind do make this
my last will and Testament that is to say I give my soul to
God who gave it hoping at the Resurrection to be raised again
through the merits and atonement of the Lord Jesus Christ as
to my Body I desire to be interred at the discretion of my
Executors hereinafter named & I do hereby revoke and annul
all former wills heretofore made as to my worldly Goods which
it hath pleased God to give me I dispose of them as follows: And
I have first it is my will that all my Just debts be paid in
manner hereafter to be named.

I have bequeathed my will and desire is that my son Charles should
have the one hundred & fifty Acres on the South end of my Commission
of Land and all the same as long as he lives with fifty one Acres
and a half purchased by me of Rankin being part of Parklands
that for the first time he can get and apply the proceeds to the
payment of whatever sum he may owe for said fifty one &
a half Acres but the said Charles is to be at liberty to purchase
the same himself provided he will give more than any one
else & he may at any time his choice not sell said land before
mentioned provided he takes upon himself the payment of what
may be due for said fifty one & a half Acres in case the said
land is sold for more than will bring the full aforementioned
the surplus is to belong to said Charles and in case it does not
bring so much as will pay said Debt then my Executor is directed
to pay up any deficiency from the rest of my estate in his hands
and the said Charles is hereby fully empowered to convey said
land the said title being vested in him for that purpose all
the balance of my land I give and bequeath to my son Charles
to him and his heirs forever I also give my said son Charles
my riding horse & saddle which I purchased of James T.
Ellorwood of Shaver's Creek.

I have third I give and bequeath to my Daughter Eliza paper
my negro man Edderborough his wife Fanny and her children
Rachel, Susan & Sarah with their future increase also my
young small mare to her and her heirs forever.

I have fourth I give my grand Daughter Eliza paper my
negro Boy Willard but it is my will and desire that before
my said grand Eliza paper be before she arrives to the age
of twenty one years & leaves no heirs then in that case it is my
will that the said Eliza Boy shall return & become a part
of my estate.

I have fifth to my grand Daughter Mary I give and
bequeath my negro boy Richard & my negro girl Betty
& her future increase also the Bed and the necessary clothing
herewith belonging but it is my will and desire that should
my said grand Daughter Mary (Murrell) die before she
arrives to the age of twenty one years & leaves no heirs then in
that case it is my will and desire the property now left to my
said grand Daughter shall return & become a part of my estate.

I also give my said grand son fifty dollars which her father (James
Ellorwood) I give and bequeath to my grand children Margaret
William & Richard Murrell & Eliza Murrell one hundred
& fifty dollars at the death of my wife and above what
may be their equal portions as heirs after mentioned.
I have seventh I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret
Marden my negro Boy John which said she has now a possession
in law also my negro Boy Telford to her and her heirs forever.
I have eighth to my daughter Fanny I give and bequeath
my negro woman Delany my negro Boy Henry which negroes she
has now in possession and my negro girl Annina with their
future increase to her and her heirs forever.

I have ninth I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza George the
hundred Dollars to be paid by my Executors all of the proceeds
of my estate in annual instalments.

I have tenth I give to my Beloved wife Margaret during her natural
life the use of my negro man Harry Capen & my negro Boy
Robbie my negro woman Lucely Salaman and my girl Annina
also the farm which I have devised to my son Charles provided she
shall choose to live on it with all such of my household & kitchen
furniture & carriage horse cattle sheep & pigs & wagon & her and
gaming utensils of any description which she may want and
at her death it is my will and desire that all the property of
whatever kind & whatsoever found except such as is already given of
may be equally divided between all my children except my son Charles
who is the legal representative of such as may be dead or have heretofore died.
But it is my will and desire that the portion which may be coming
to my daughter Eliza may be vested in my son Charles as her trustee
who is to hold the same for her use and benefit during her life and at
her death to belong to the children & Representatives.

I have eleventh It is my desire and desire that all the property of
may pass not hereby disposed and also such of the household
furniture cattle &c. which my wife may not want may be sold
by my Executor at his discretion it is further my will desire
that my daughter Margaret shall have any negro girl Annina
and I desire that my negro woman Lucely devised to my wife and
her youngest child may be sold by my Executor if necessary
he giving William Marden the preference of purchasing and if it is
then it is not necessary for her to be sold and my wife is willing &
desires her and her youngest child should be valued to my daughter
Margaret and be deducted out of her portion which would be coming
to her at the death of my wife in case it is not necessary for her to be
sold and my wife is unwilling to part with her & desires that the
negro girl Annina before mentioned remain also with my wife until
her death and then to go to my daughter Margaret as before directed.

I have twelfth It is my will and desire that all the money that may be
in my house at my death together with all debts due the Bank note or
any account may be applied & appropriated by my Executor to be
devoted to the payment of my Just debts & whatever there may be
remaining it is my will and desire may be equally divided between
