And the name of said amon I Presley Hill of the County of Logan & State of Kentucky being law and well and body but of a sound and disposing mind & memory calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do think proper to make and ordain this my last will and testament that amon first of all I commend my soul to all mighty God that gave it and my said body the earth to be buried in Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors. As touching my worldly goods that I have placed and bequeathed with my said and bequeathed in the following manner

Item 1st My will & desire is that my just debts be first paid and what ever monies after paying my just debts & funeral charges may be on hand and due me shall be laid out in land at the discretion of my Executors for the express use & purpose of a home & place of residence for my beloved wife Sarah I full in and during her life a widowhood and my children during their minority should my wife live to see all our children arrive to the age of twenty one year & nevertheless my will and desire is that after the death of my beloved wife the Land so purchased shall be sold to the best advantage and the money arising from the sale be equally divided between my children (Wm) Philip E James and Malinda Henry John W Joseph Astor and James Sarah E Scamuel & George W and in the event that my beloved wife should marry my will and desire is that she hold her said land two one third part of the Land so directed to be purchased during her life and after her death to revert back to my children & be sold with the remaining two thirds and my will & desire is that my Executors manage the remaining two thirds to the best advantage for the benefit of all my said mentioned children

Item 2nd My will and desire is as touching my negro property that the Law is strictly observed in all its bearing & meaning in the divisions of them between my beloved wife & children I do hereby declare it to be my will in this case also touching my perishable property so as to insure an equal division as may be with the exceptions of the first item and the provisions therein pertained and upon the death of my beloved wife a general and equal division to be place between all my children I do hereby constitute my beloved wife Sarah Hill and my son Philip E full Executors & Executors to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking & disavowing all other bequests made by me I do hereby ratify and confirm this to be my last will and that no suit shall be required of my Executors & Executors unless upon complaint before the Court of ward of the Estate & that my Executors & Executors be allowed no commission upon the value of my negro estate And I do hereby constitute my said Executors & Executors give and convey to my said children as we named Wm Wilson of the same I have hereto subscribed my name & affixed my seal this Eighth day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eighty Seven and our twenty seven
