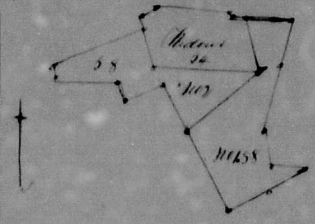

Let the land be divided as follows with land, Beginning at a large post oak stump
on the bank of a river thence with the meanders of said river S 41° E 10 poles S 48° E 10 poles S 44° E 26 poles S 33° E 12 poles to a white oak
black stump thence N 30° E 10 poles to a black corner to lot 122
thence N 46° E 74 poles to a black corner to the widow dower thence N 12° E
8 poles to a stake at the line thence with the said river thence N 77° E 34
to a black stump thence N 56° E 16 poles to a black stump thence N 87° E 24
poles to a black stump thence S 41° E 6 poles to a black stump thence N 76° E 12
poles to the Beginning of lot 122 and extend to a black stump
