Also my stock of all and every kind likewise my plantation utensils house hold and kitchen furniture in short all the house hold things together with every other other species property I may die possess with my slaves excepted which at my death all above the age of twenty five years I wish to be left free all below that age to remain under the care and control of my named son William Cardwell until they may arrive to the age of twenty five and then let free as those above named. 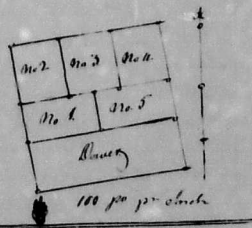
